1 What is a GPA Calculator?

GPA calculator is a new Self Service feature to help you calculate your GPA automatically.

2 How it works?

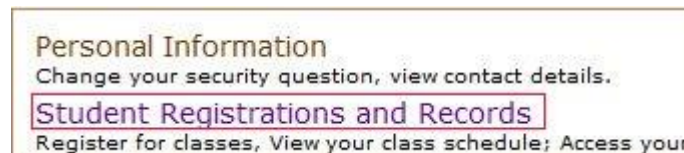
Your Grade Point Average (GPA) is calculated by dividing the total number of grade points earned by the total number of credit hours attempted. Your grade point average may range from 0.0 to a 4.0.

Depending on the currently registered hours, you can calculate your anticipated GPA before you get your actual final grades by using the grade you expect to have in a specific course and so on. By clicking submit the calculator will calculate your expected (target) GPA depending on your entries and on your current GPA (current accumulative points and accumulative credit hours)

3 How to access it?

Please follow the steps below to access GPA calculator:

1. Log in to your MyBanner account
2. Click the tab Student Registration and Records
3. Select Registration submenu
4. Click on GPA Calculator

4 How to use it?

After following the link GPA calculator you will be asked to select a term if you haven't selected once before, please **select the current term** (the term that you want to calculate your GPA for), **selecting a wrong term will not give you meaningful results.**
